



Tucson couple joins lawsuit to legalize same sex marriage in AZ



Maggie Vespa, Feb. 25, 2014 TUCSON (KGUN9-TV) - As the SB 1062 battle wages on, another fight is pushing Arizona to the front lines of the gay rights debate. Jeffrey Ferst and Peter Bramley are the seventh same sex couple to join a mass lawsuit, challenging Arizona's ban on same sex marriage. They are the only Tucson couple to do so.

"We believe in each other. We believe in our marriage," said Ferst. "So it's very easy for us to take this step and go public because somebody needs to do it." That suit was first filed in January. Both Ferst and Bramley say joining the pool of plaintiffs, as SB 1062 comes to a head, underscores the importance of their fight.
